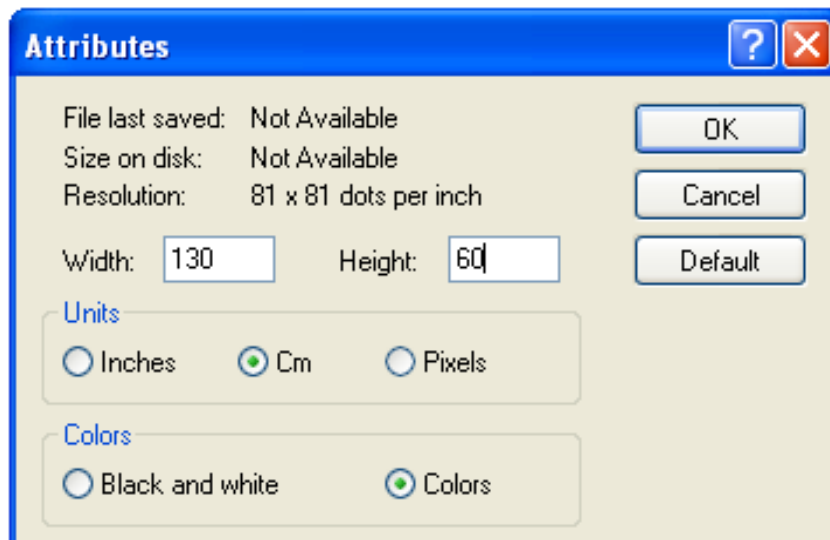
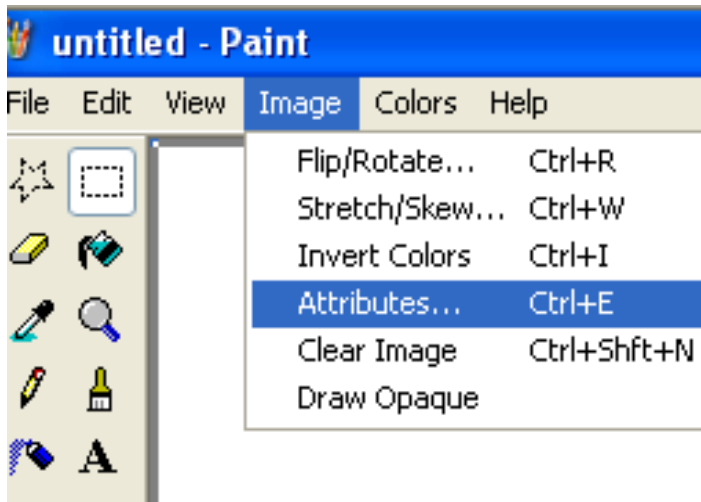


Create a Decal in Paint

1. Go To **Start > Programs > Accessories > Paint**
2. Set the image size to fit your surface. Go to **Image > Attributes.**



The image above is measured in *Centimeters*.

3. Your *canvas size* will now be the size of the decal you are creating.
4. Using *Shapes* create a decal. You can also copy and paste an image onto your paint canvas. Example below:



5. Go to **File > Page Setup**. The important thing here is “*Scaling*”. Be sure you are using “**Adjust to > 100% Normal Size**”.
6. Go to **File > Print**.
7. Your Decal is ready for placement on your mock up.

****ProDESKTOP users****

Be sure to save your decal as a Bitmap. You can then *import* your decal into the ProDESKTOP program and use it in a **Photo Album**.

Go to **File > Save as...** Save it here:
C\Program Files\PTC
ProDESKTOP8.0\Program\Bitmaps.

You can then apply the decal on a part on a Photo Album by *Selecting Faces > Apply Decal*. Resize the decal using the handles. See Below:
